








LOCATION



About Tartu, EST – the City of Good Thoughts

Tartu is the second largest city in Estonia with a population of around 100,000. Known as the "City of Good Thoughts", it is home to the University of Tartu, founded in 1632, which has shaped the city's cultural and intellectual life for centuries.

Tartu is compact and easy to explore, with most hotels, restaurants and attractions located close to the center. The city has a strong sporting tradition and regularly hosts both national and international competitions. Competition venue A. Le Coq Sports Hall, one of Tartu's main indoor arenas, located only a short distance from the city center.

Distances: Tallinn 180 km (2 h drive), Riga 250 (3 h drive)

WKF RULES

The current WKF rules are implemented with slight adjustments. A standard elimination cup system will be utilised, awarding a single third-place position. For categories comprising three to four athletes, a round-robin format will be employed. The organiser retains the right to merge or modify categories containing only one or two participants.

Kumite

U10 1 min, 6 points U12, U14 1,5 min, 6 points

Cadet, junior, senior WKF rules

Kata

U10 free kata and can be repeated in all rounds
U12 free kata and can be repeated from the 3rd round but not the last
U14 free kata and can be repeated from the 4rd round but not the last
Cadet, junior, senior WKF rules

Age restrictions

Registration and participation is allowed also in the next higher age group.

U10	Kata 6-9, Kumite 8-9
U12	Kata 8-11, Kumite 10-11
U14	Kata and Kumite 10-13
U16	Kata and Kumite 12-15
U18	Kata and Kumite 14-17
Senior	Kata 14+. Kumite 18+

All matters not regulated by the WKF competition rules, the Estonian Karate League guidelines or this bulletin will be resolved by the panel of referees or the organising committee of the competition.

Protest fee is 100€.

Every category best three athletes will be awarded with medal and diploma. One third place is awarded. Medal ceremonies for all categories will be scheduled at appropriate times throughout the day.
